When the school is closed would you like your children to be involved in fun activities at the parish lounge?

From **13-15 June** our school is closed so that the teachers can attend the Catholic Convention in Wellington. They are staying at the Home of Compassion in Island Bay where Blessed Mother Aubert is buried. While the school is closed Janice Basile (from the Italian Doughnut family) and Father Darren are organising a team of 16 people to cover three days of activities for our children. The team is part of the Mission coming to our parish during that week. They are proposing that there be one day for each school team. Wednesday for PAUA Year 5+6; Thursday for KINA Year 3+4 and Friday Family Session. There will be no cost and children will need to bring their lunchboxes as usual with morning tea and lunch like they do at school. The kids will really enjoy being with their friends and sharing the activities that will be provided. If you are interested in having your children take part, please sign up at the school office.

The afternoon of the 20th June.

We are asking you for another favour. The teachers from this school will be attending a NZEI Te Riu Roa paid union meeting regarding the *Kua Tae Te Wā* - It's Time campaign. The campaign aims to free teachers to teach and principals to lead, by getting the additional support and staff that schools need. The meetings will allow our teachers to discuss how the Ministry of Education has responded to changes that the union is seeking.

Thank you so much for collecting your children last term when the teachers' union called a meeting of members and we didn't have enough staff to supervise children for the afternoon session. You were so supportive that we only had 40 children who stayed for the afternoon and we were able to send two relievers home. The NZEI has set down the afternoon of 20th June as the next paid union meeting, starting at 1.30 p.m. at Baypark stadium. Our teaching staff are members of NZEI and legally entitled to attend this meeting. The NZEI can only call two paid union meetings a year so this will be the last one for 2018.

Tomorrow St. Michael's are coming.

We are hosting the teachers and teacher aides from St. Michael's, Rotorua tomorrow from 9.15-12.30. They have closed their school for the day and they are coming to look around our school to observe the teachers in action. What a lovely compliment to us and to our children.

Harold, the giraffe, is coming.

Life Education Trust provide an educator and a specially designed caravan classroom so that children all around New Zealand can learn about healthy living, our bodies, how to make and keep friends, dangerous drugs and behaviour, being part of a family, nutrition and exercise.

Not all our children will be learning all of these things. Each time the Life Education caravan comes (once every two years) children learn about one of these units. On Monday 18th June the PAPI parents and any new parents who haven't seen the caravan are invited to come and look through the caravan. The educator will be there to answer questions and to explain what the children are learning during the week.



Composting

The Paua team have been learning all about building a healthy, nutritious compost heap (with no bad smells). This is a programme shared by a team of enviro warriors with schools all around the Bay. Children have been very excited about building their own compost bin at school and they are keen to build one at home now.



Katie Horrocks is volunteering at our school planting and building up our soil so that we can have an orchard and berry patch. If you would like to be one of the Mums that gardens please have a chat with Katie, the more hands the better. Thank you to Mrs Phillipps (Kina teacher) for donating a strong feijoa tree for our school orchard. Are there any other families who would like to bring a fruit/citrus tree in for us to plant in our orchard? Just drop in.
